Subject: Board Consideration: OSU Extension request for Providence Community Benefit

Hi Mary and Laura,

I would like to request the Board's permission to apply for a grant in partnership with the Oregon State University's (OSU) Extension office in Yamhill County. The grant opportunity is from Providence Newberg Medical Center Community Benefit. Providence's Yamhill Service Area Advisory Council is seeking community partners to aid in improving the health of the community in the areas identified in the Community Health Needs Assessment.

The focus area addressed in our funding request of up to \$50,000 is a reduction of childhood and adolescent obesity in Yamhill County. While this funding was not included in our Health and Human Services 2016-2017 Adopted budget, we have sufficient expense authority. These awards are generally for one year with possible extension if funds aren't fully expensed.

OSU Extension in Yamhill County currently has a part-time employee, Jennifer Bunn who teaches nutrition education (Healthy Kids) for the SNAP-Ed program. If awarded, we will subcontract funds to increase Ms. Bunn's time in order to include the exercise/physical activity component of the program. Our request will also include funding to support our collaboration through our Public Health Division with OSU Extension in conducting a comprehensive program evaluation. The evaluation will be used for program design, improvement and to formulate recommendations for possible program expansion.

If our grant request is successful, I will return to the Board to request approval of the amount awarded.
