Hi Mary and Laura,

I would like to request the Board's permission to apply for the School Based Health Center (SBHC) Mental Health Grant being offered through the Oregon Health Authority. If funded, the grant will continue mental health services at two locations: Willamina and Yamhill Carlton. If approved, the approximate amount we will be applying for is \$273,200 to support both locations for the 2017-2019 biennium.

This is a continuation grant for onsite mental health support and services; we are currently funded in the 2015-2017 biennium. Both schools are supportive of this request and hope to continue with current behavioral health supports.

If our grant application is successful, I will return to the Board to request ratification for actual amounts awarded. We will include expense authority in the 2017-2018 budget in anticipation of this opportunity. Please let me know if you have any questions.
