At this time the HHS Administration building does not have an ADA access point as required by code. At one time there was a ramp to the back, however, it did not meet code and was dismantled due to safety concerns as the wood had become severely rotted.

On November 14, 2019 Facilities solicited quotes for the design and construction of a new ramp that would meet ADA requirements under the 2010 Federal and State codes. One of the items that must be addressed to make this compliant is the replacement of the door to meet ADA opening requirements, this too has been added in the quotes.

A request for quotes was sent to three local contractors with only one responding, the quotes are as follows;

Based on the responses and the need to complete this project I respectfully recommend the County accept the quote from Integrity Builders.
