DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

Mid-Valley Behavioral Care Network and Yamhill County

Mid-Valley Behavioral Care Network (MVBCN) shall disburse \$165,645.35 to Yamhill County for the purpose described in Section 2. These funds are Yamhill County's share of funds remaining from the Rental Assistance Program (RAP).

MVBCN was contracted by the State of Oregon from February 2014 through June 2017 for RAP. MVBCN's initial and subsequent applications for RAP were on behalf of the three-county region comprised of current members Marion and Polk Counties and former member Yamhill County. MVBCN entered into subcontracts with the aforementioned counties for rental assistance payments and supported housing services for individuals eligible for RAP. The counties received funding from MVBCN for rental assistance and related expenses, staff, and administration/overhead. MVBCN's Board of Directors, through its Executive Committee, has directed MVBCN to disburse the remaining RAP funds to the three counties.

Yamhill County agrees to use these funds solely for the purpose(s) described.

1. By execution of this Agreement, Yamhill County certifies under penalty of perjury that:
 - a. To the best of Yamhill County's knowledge, Yamhill County is not in violation of any tax laws described in ORS 305.380(4); and
 - b. Yamhill County has not discriminated against minority, women or small business enterprises in obtaining any required subcontracts; and
 - c. Yamhill County agrees to comply with federal and state laws and regulations.

2. Purpose of the funds:
 - a. Yamhill County shall utilize these funds for the following activities, which are consistent with the service description in the RAP contracts between the State of Oregon and MVBCN:
 - i) Mental health supported housing services that allow individuals to live as independently as possible in the community and to access the appropriate support services on a voluntary basis.
 - ii) Mental health rental assistance services to assist individuals who are 18 years of age or older with Serious Mental Illness (SMI), as defined in OAR 309-032-0311 (14), and who meet at least one of the following criteria in paying for rental housing:
 - i. Transitioning from the Oregon State Hospital;
 - ii. Transitioning from a licensed residential setting;
 - iii. Without supported housing are at risk of reentering a licensed residential or hospital setting. "Supported housing" is a combination of financial assistance and supportive services that allows an individual to live as independently as possible in their own home;
 - iv. Homeless as defined in 42 U.S.C. § 11302; or
 - v. At risk of being homeless.

3. Payment:

MVBCN shall disburse \$165,645.35 following execution of this Agreement.

4. Reporting:


Yamhill County shall provide records on the use of funds disbursed under this Agreement to MVBCN and/or to federal or state authorities upon request.


